

2018 Healthy Youth Survey Results - Errata

Erratum 2: Inclusion of Optional Questions.

Results for the optional questions were inadvertently excluded from Peninsula School District results. The optional question responses were added back in to the datasets and results posted on AskHYS.net.

The impact of the error was on the following schools, district, county, ESD and state results:

- Schools in Peninsula School District, Grades 8, 10, and 12
- Peninsula School District Grades, 8, 10, and 12
- Pierce County, Grades 8, 10, and 12
- Puget Sound ESD 121, Grades 8, 10, and 12
- State sample, Grade 8 only

The number of survey respondents did not change, but there are additional responses for all optional questions for those listed above.

Table 1 compares the updated survey results, posted on www.AskHYS.net on April 30th, 2019, to the original results for the Grade 8 State sample. The prevalence estimates for the Grade 8 State sample vary, at the most, by +/- 0.3 for the tear-off questions.
